Dear Stamford Collegiate Students and Families,

I am very pleased to share news of a decision that Stamford Collegiate will be one of six DSBNSB secondary schools moving to a new in-person schedule for **certain classes (see chart below)**.

Due to the fact that we have many classes that will be lower than 15 students when combining Cohort A & Cohort B, the in-person schedule **for the classes listed below** will change from our current schedule of two cohorts attending different days of the week to one where our Cohorts A and B will be combined for these smaller classes.

For example:

If your student is currently enrolled in Cohort A or B in the course below (or any course in the chart):

ENG 1L/2L (Grade 9/10 Essential Level English) Period 1 Ms. Smithson

Starting November 30, they will now attend this class twice a week in person, as they will attend in-person on Cohort A **and** Cohort B day, as well as whenever there is a study hall for this class.

If your student's class is **not** listed below, then they will continue to follow the same schedule they have now for that class (meaning they attend once a week to the in-person class and every other Wednesday). Classes that, when Cohort A and B are combined are greater than 15, are **not** listed below.

Students will be expected to follow the same protocols to ensure safety. School will continue to start at 10:15 a.m. and end at 2:25 p.m.

We want to stress that while we are excited to welcome students to school more regularly for certain classes, student and staff safety is still paramount to us and the DSBNSB. This adjusted in-person schedule was reviewed by the Ministry of Education and Niagara Region Public Health (NRPH) to ensure that it would be safe for our students to attend certain classes more frequently. NRPH advised us that they support our new model and have no concerns.

In preparation for this transition, our dedicated teachers and custodians will work together to prepare their classrooms, and to support student safety, student success and student well-being.

Students in Cohort O can continue with 'fully online', but as mentioned in previous communication, this model is adaptive and families can choose to have their child attend in-person.

Also, DSBN has worked with Niagara Student Transportation Services (NSTS) to update the bus routes to accommodate the new schedule. If your student is coming more regularly for certain classes, this will be effective for their bussing starting November 30.

Finally, we realize that you may have questions that may not be answered in this email. As we move into this model with certain classes attending more regularly, the health and safety of your student will remain our top priority. Please contact us at the school with your questions or concerns.

We will provide each affected student with a calendar for December and January that outlines which days they come to school.
