Dear students and families of Stamford Collegiate Secondary School

We hope that you are all enjoying some rest during this break!

The Ministry of Education has notified us that schools will be closed for regular education in-person learning starting on Monday April 19.

We are moving to a model of Period 1, 2, 3, 4 rotating for the duration of online learning. Below are the online schedules for the next 2 weeks:

While schools remain physically closed, students will be participating in daily synchronous learning through Microsoft Teams or Google Classrooms. Starting on April 19, it is very important that students log into their assigned class at the time **instructed by your teacher** to participate in your daily learning. Secondary schools will continue to follow the daily schedule posted with one course a day and teachers will provide synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities for students. For our school, classes will run from 10:15 a.m. to 2:25 p.m.
