

Community Involvement Hours -Stamford Collegiate-

General Information

- Every student in Ontario must complete 40 hours of community involvement to earn their O.S.S.D.
- Students can begin to collect their community involvement hours following Grade 8 graduation.
- Community Involvement hours must be completed outside of school time (lunch hour, after school, weekends or holidays)

General Information

- Community Involvement activities may take place in a variety of settings, including notfor-profit organizations, public sector institutions (hospitals, schools...) and informal settings
- Students can NOT fulfill the requirement through activities that are counted toward a credit (co-op), paid work or by taking on duties that are normally performed by a paid employee.

Examples of Eligible and Ineligible Activities

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- Coaching, organizing track meets, camp counsellor
- Organizing community projects- parades, fairs, community clean-ups
- Sunday school, tutoring, reading buddies
- Humane Society- animal care
- Scouts, girls guides, breakfast programs

INELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- Handling money or any other valuables (art, antiques...)
- If it displaces a paid employee (working at a corner store)
- Operation of a vehicle or power tool
- Normal duties performed at home (daily chores)
- Take place during the school day.

How to Input Hours

- Navigate to the VOLUNTEER DASHBOARD and click ADD HOURS
- You will need the following information to submit hours:
 - Name of Organization
 - Contact e-mail
 - Contact Name
 - Contact Phone #



How to Input Hours

- You will also have to add in a DESCRIPTION of the Community Involvement (i.e., I participated in the Stair Climb for Cancer)
- Click SAVE and SUBMIT
- Your activity will then be sent to the Community Agency contact person, your parent/guardian as well as your Guidance Counsellor for approval.
